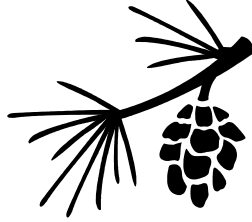

Our region continues to get good news on declining Covid infection numbers. There has been some revision of the vaccine distribution which has limited the nearby vaccine sites for the over 55 years age group.
